1. bristly - If something is bristly, it is covered with short, stiff hairs.
2. dreadful - If something is dreadful, it is scary or terrible.
3. adamant - If someone is adamant about something, he or she is very determined and won't change his or her mind about it.
4. inevitable - If something is inevitable, it cannot be avoided or stopped.
5. summoning - If you are summoning someone, you are calling for the person to come.
6. nuisance - Something or someone that bothers you can be a nuisance.
7. sedentary - If you have a sedentary job or lifestyle, you are sitting down most of the time.
8. oblige - When you oblige someone, you help the person.
9. boasting - Someone who is boasting is telling other people wonderful things about himself or herself.
10. sway - When things sway, they swing slowly back and forth.
