

One Week Suggested Plan for whole group and guided reading

Monday Schedule- Day 1 **Whole Group Instruction** (60 minutes)

- Question of the day
- Read aloud
- Comprehension, plot and setting
- Story Structure teach-model, guided practice, practice apply-could be used as a center
- Introduce vocabulary Word Scribe (Perfect for Centers)
 - We would suggest modeling this activity for the first nine weeks of school and then for the last 3-nine week periods add writing objectives you are working on and implement them into this activity in your center.
 - This should be a folder center students take to their seats and work on with a weekly vocabulary list and a weekly rubric for each student.
- Fluency: Model Oral Fluency activity
- Teach word attack skills

Monday **No Small Groups** – Introduce Centers (30 minutes)

- Small groups may need more time the first nine weeks
- Pick and choose centers that can be used weekly, just adapted to fit the new story. These can be picked from the teacher's edition. Once centers are mastered they will run smoothly, make your expectations very clear. Model, model, model!
 - Review Center rules
 - Go over every center, expectations, directions, model the activity, post the schedule for Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday
 - Answer any questions, make your directions very clear
 - Practice changing centers, expectations, timing and movement of centers (This will benefit the teacher in the long run.)

Tuesday Schedule – Day 2 Whole Group Instruction (45 minutes)

- Question of the Day Read Aloud (5 minutes)
- Comprehension, Transparency (10 minutes)
- Plot and Setting (15 minutes)
- Read Story, Monitor comprehension (15 minutes)
- Vocabulary Review (10 minutes)
- Practice Book (story map) could be used for a center in the future. Model this activity for students and complete together. This is the focus skill and has already been modeled on Monday.

Tuesday – Day 2 Guided Reading Groups (45 minutes)

Red Group (Using Day 3 plans in teacher's edition) (15 minutes)

- Build Background
- Set a Purpose for reading, preview the book
- Build vocabulary with activity from small group instruction manual
- Assign worksheet for students to complete at their seats worksheet found in small group instruction manual
- If time allows you may want to begin reading

Blue Group Guided Reading (15 minutes)

- Build Background
- Preview/Set Purpose
- Build Vocabulary with activity from small group instruction manual
- Assign vocabulary worksheet with activity from small group instruction manual
- If time allows after building vocabulary you may want to begin reading

Green Group Guided Reading (15 minutes)

- Build Background
- Preview/Set Purpose
- Build Vocabulary with activity from small group instruction manual
- Assign vocabulary independent practice, in small group instruction manual
- If time allows after building vocabulary you may want to begin reading

Wednesday Schedule – Day 3 Whole Group Instruction (45 minutes)

- Finish reading the story if you have not finished and discuss comprehension questions/question of the day, Day 3
- Review Plot and Setting, complete worksheets Extra support, Practice Book, Challenge
- Vocabulary, Reinforce word meanings
- Read “Are You Laughing at Me?”
- Compare texts

Wednesday – Day 3 Guided Reading Groups (45 minutes)

Red Group Guided Reading (15 minutes)

- During Reading monitor comprehension
- Discuss questions on the inside back cover of the book
- Review Focus Skill and assign worksheet to be completed at their seats, they may work on this together as a center activity

Blue Group Guided Reading (15 minutes)

- During Reading small book monitor comprehension
- Discuss questions on the inside back cover of the book
- Review Focus Skill and assign worksheet, this can be worked on at their seats either as a group or independently

Green Group Guided Reading (15 minutes)

- During Reading monitor comprehension
- Discuss questions on the inside back cover of the book
- Review focus skill assign plot chart worksheet, students can finish this at their seats.

Thursday Schedule – Day 4 Whole Group Instruction (45 minutes)

- Listen to the story on CD (if needed) (15 minutes)
- May want to ask the question of the day after reviewing the story and vocabulary
- Model Oral Fluency, Display Transparency (15 minutes)
- Teach Forms of Fiction, use transparency (15 minutes)
- Practice and Apply, complete differentiated worksheets based on students reading levels for understanding (Extra support, practice book, challenge)

Thursday – Day 4 Guided Reading Groups (45 minutes)

Red Group Guided Reading (15 minutes)

- Discuss what was read on Day 4, finish the book if needed
- Follow up with discussion questions under Think Critically After Reading Activities, (small manual)

Blue Group Guided Reading (15 minutes)

- Discuss what was read on Day 4, finish the book if needed
- Follow up with discussion questions under Think Critically After Reading Activities

Green Group Guided Reading (15 minutes)

- Discuss what was read on Day 4, finish the book if needed
- Follow up with discussion questions under Think Critically After Reading Activities

Friday - Day 5 Whole Group Instruction

- Question of the Day
- Review Vocabulary
- Assessment

Friday – Day 5 Guided Reading Small Groups

Red Group Guided Reading

- Students will take the assessment with the RTI aide.
- Students are going to pre-read next week's story and preview the vocabulary and focus skill with the RTI aide.

Blue Group Guided Reading

- Bring center folders to the table and assess finished work in folders as a group.
- Conference on completed work and work that needs to be finished.
- Students choose one completed center to be graded and turn in to completed basket.
- Students clean out folder for next week and straighten crates.
