1. Hear and read clues to find what's hidden in the bag.
2. Hear or read three events that need to be put in the correct sequence.
3. Select from multiple activities before typing in numbers to put the events in the correct sequence.
4. Arrange sentence parts into the correct order to make sense.
5. Read statements from books about dinosaurs and decide which statements are real and which statements are make believe.
6. Place pictures in the background that describes the story.
7. Listen to and follow story directions.
8. Select an interactive story and quiz to practice working with the main idea.
9. Read a story before checking comprehension, recreating the story, or filling in the gaps.
10. Interactive site to practice main idea using short story passages.
11. Read sentences to find the facts and opinions.
12. Read passages about planets and answer multiple-choice questions.
