

# Phonemic Awareness

## Student Activities' Descriptions

1. Listen to and match beginning sounds.
2. Match beginning sounds with pictures.
3. Lanolin Sheep says a word, takes off the beginning sound. Students identify what is left.
4. Find the picture that starts with the same sound as the given picture.
5. Students fill in the missing beginning, middle, or ending sounds of words.
6. Students hear a sound (phoneme) and click on letters that make that sound.
7. Identify picture that starts with a different sound than the others.
8. Introduces rhyming, with plenty of oral directions to listen to.
9. Select rhyming activities from this Project Web.
10. Double click on a box and listen to the picture names. Then they drag a red X to the picture that doesn't rhyme.
11. Students say the name of the pictured animal, count the syllables, and click on the correct number.
12. Match middle sounds in this Clifford concentration game.
13. Listen to sounds and blend them to choose a matching picture.
14. Listen to onset and rime and blend them to choose a matching picture.
15. Listen to a word and sound substitution and click on a picture of the new word.
16. Students listen to names and click on the letter or letters that make the beginning sound.
17. Students listen to a variety of environmental sounds and listen for sounds that match.
18. Determine the number of syllables when words are spoken.
